## Foreword

This, 14th ASIAN Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies, being held at Damai Beach Resort, Kuching, Malaysia, from 27-28 Mar 2026, is organised by AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers), It marks AMER's 53rd international conference to be organised, which is fully managed by AMER's subsidiary, emAs (AMER Event Management & Services) under emAs emAs Resources

The Game Changer 2021 (#GC2021), initiated in early 2021, requires that contributions from Malaysia include international co-authors and aims to increase the number of publications contributed by multinational authors. We believe that the initiative would significantly increase the likelihood that our publications will be indexed by more reputable indexing bodies, such as Scopus. As such, commencing in 2021, only multinational-authored contributions from Malaysia shall be accepted for publication.

As anticipated, the new Clarivate Analytics ruling for publications commencing Jan 2026, which would not be automatically WoS-indexed as in previous years, has significantly reduced the number of participants. Nevertheless, AcE-Bs2026Kuching, still managed to attract a total of 22 approved abstracts, with authors from 13 countries. The majority of the abstracts were in collaboration with Malaysian authors. International contributions were obtained from Indonesia (8 numbers / 36%), followed by China, Morocco, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, and the UK (2 each), and Cyprus, Jordan, New Zealand, the Philippines, Spain, and Thailand (1 each).

The approved abstracts were grouped into 12 subcategories, although many could have been easily placed under more than one category. The top four categories, in order of popularity, were Health / Healing Environment (HE) 7 abstracts, and followed by Communication / Social Media Environment, Legal Matters, Rural Environment, and Urban Environment (2 each).

The approved abstracts were finally transformed into 18 approved full papers, a return of 82.0%. The papers approved were simply grouped generally under 10 sub-categories, although quite a number could have been easily placed under more than one category.

The top four categories, in order of popularity, were Health / Healing Environment (HE) with 6 papers, followed by Communication / Social Media Environment, Rural Environment and Urban Environment, 2 papers each.

Hopefully this conference will inspire and encourage more researchers to participate in our forthcoming serial conferences.

Thanks again for your continuous support and contributions as always, and hope for an enlightening conference!

## About AcE-Bs

### Background

The success of the 1st National Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies, InCEBS2009 held at Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Shah Alam, Malaysia, from 14-15 Nov 2009, inspired the organiser to organise future conferences beyond the nation. The AcE-Bs, an initial acronym for the ASEAN Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies, targeted venues in ASEAN countries; it was later extended to Asian countries, giving rise to the current acronym for the Asian Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies.

The main theme of the AcE-Bs conferences addresses Environment-Behaviour (E-B) issues affecting Asian communities living in both Asian and non-Asian countries. E-B issues affecting non-Asian communities are also most welcome.

Prior to 2012, AcE-Bs was organized by cE-Bs (Centre for Environment-Behaviour Studies, FSPU, UiTM, Malaysia, supported by AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers) and ABRA (Association of Behavioural Researchers on Asians). Post-2012, with AMER formalised, it became the main organiser of all four annual conferences, and at times co-organised with nations of the International Scientific Committee. AMER's Event Management & Services (emAs), a subsidiary of AMER and also a private entity, manages all of AMER's events, under emAs (Emas Emas Resources).

## Conference Policy

- 1) **All instructions** for submissions should be strictly followed.
- 2) **Authors names** together with the sequencing are not allowed to be changed (strictly). Authors names as per the Abstract approved should also be used for the Full Paper. Numbers of authors exceeding the max 4 shall be surcharged RM400. For 6-8 numbers of authors shall be surcharged an additional RM800.
- 3) **All communications** shall be transmitted to the 1<sup>st</sup> Author only (strictly), the email as per submitted in the Abstract. Please cite your Abstract No. for all communications.
- 4) **Submission deadlines** as per the conference Timeline is strictly adhered.
- 5) **All payments** received are non-refundable (including cancellation of participation, abstracts / papers rejected, or non-submission of amended full paper within the deadlines). **Registration Fees** shall be based on the status of the 1st Author, no matter whoever shall be presenting.
- 6) **Attendance** is NOT compulsory for your Oral Presentation. The papers shall still be considered for publication in the final Proceeding (E-BPJ). However, non-Oral Presentation and non-payment for Publication Fees to be submitted together with the Conference Registration Fees shall disqualify the papers from being considered for the Best Paper Awards.
- 7) **Oral Presenters** attending must register during the stipulated time as per the Programme (*Latecomers shall be considered as not presenting @ not attending*). Oral Presenters should have submitted their power point presentation at least 1 week before the conference, so that the presentation schedule can be finalised by then.
- 8) **Breakout Schedules** shall be released during the Conf Registration. As Oral Presenters are expected to attend the whole session, any special request for rescheduling of their oral presentation does not arise.
- 9) **Full Papers** accepted for the conference is not a guarantee that it would be published in the final Proceeding. It is compulsory to submit both the non-refundable Conference Registration Fees and Publication Fees, together with the Full Paper submission. Failing which, the Full Paper shall not be reviewed, nor published even in the draft Proceeding.
- 10) **Publication** of the Conference Proceeding shall be based on the amended full papers only, as recommended by the International Scientific Committee (ISC) after the double-blind review process. The draft Proceeding published in the conference web during the conference is solely meant as a reference for participants during the conference.

**11) Conference Packs and Certificates** shall only be provided to participants who attend the conference physically. The Certificate must be collected during the Certificate Presentation ceremony. No special requests will be entertained.

**12) Conference e-Certificates** for virtual participants shall be emailed to participants attending. Only one certificate per person shall be issued, that is Presenter, Co-Author or Participant.

**13) Visa** application for face-to-face conferences is the sole responsibility of the participant. Please apply **Tourist Visa** (Not visa for attending the conference) on your own. The Organiser will not issue any Letter of Support for a Visa Application, and should not be held responsible if you are unable to obtain your visa in time for the conference.

**14) Administrative Fees** RM200 surcharge applies for any inconvenience to Conf Sec.

**15) Publication matters for papers rejected: A Note of Appeal** must be sent immediately to the Editor-in-Chief via [admin@e-jph.co.uk](mailto:admin@e-jph.co.uk) and c.c. to the Conf Sec.

**16. All submissions** (Abstracts and Full Papers) cannot be withdrawn/cancelled.

## Best Paper Awards Policy

The non-automatic WoS index for the E-BPJ, commencing publications in Jan 2026, has seriously impacted the number of conference participants. As such the Best Paper Awards have to be scaled down as follows: -

### Criteria for Best Paper Awards

1. The ranking for the Best Paper Awards shall be based only on the papers that are Orally presented (F2F) at the conference  
Published in the E-BPJ, whereby the Publication Fees is required to be submitted together with the compulsory Conference Registration Fees during the full paper submission process  
With a score above 85%  
With international co-author (non-Malaysians exempted) not co-authoring more than 1 paper. (All papers co-authored by the same international co-author will be disqualified)
2. Award winners (not representative) must be present during the Best Paper Award Announcement. Failing which, they shall be disqualified
3. The Best Paper Awards Certificates and the Cash prizes shall be provided within 1 week after the Announcement
4. Validity for the prizes is within 12 months only. Abstract Fees & Publication Fees for the next conference are not waived. Late Charges still apply for late submissions
5. Registration Fees prizes for the next conference are for the same 1st author only
6. Cash Prizes must be claimed within 1 week after the Announcement during the Post-Conference session, by providing Bank Account details to the Conf Sec. Failing which the winners will lose the cash prizes
