Foreword

This 08th Asia-Pacific International Conference on Quality of Life, AQoL2024, being co-hosted and held at the Faculty of Architecture, Dokuz Eylul University, Izmir, Turkiye on 22-24 May 2024 is organised by AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers) in collaboration with cE-Bs (Centre for Environment-Behaviour Studies, College of Built Environment, Universiti Teknologi MARA, Malaysia. It marked AMER's 46th international conference to be organised, and fully managed by AMER's subsidiary, emAs (AMER Event Management & Services) under emAs emAs Resources

The Game Changer 2021 (#GC2021) initiated in early 2021 whereby it is compulsory for contributions from Malaysia to include international co-authors, is to increase our publications to be contributed by multi-national authors. We believe that initiative would tremendously increases the chances for our publications to be indexed by more reputable indexing bodies, such as Scopus. As such, commencing 2021 only multi-national authored contributions from Malaysia shall be accepted for publications.

AQoL2024Izmir managed to attract an overall total of initially 33 numbers of abstracts, of which 2 later withdrew. Of the abstracts approved, authors from 12 countries contributed. Majority of the abstracts were in collaboration with Malaysian authors. The most were together with Indonesia (13 numbers); China, Thailand (3 each); Australia (2), followed by Maldives, Oman, Philippines, United Kingdom, Vietnam, and West Africa (1 each). Sole nations were contributed by Turkiye (3 numbers), and Australia (1 number).

The approved abstracts were finally transformed into 21 approved full papers, a return of 66%. The papers approved were simply grouped generally under 13 sub-categories, although quite a number could have been easily placed under more than one category. The top category in order of popularity involved the Urban Environment (UE), with 4 papers.

Hopefully this conference will inspire and encourage more researchers to participate in our forthcoming serial conferences.

Thanks again for your continuous support and contributions as always, and hope for an enlightening conference !

About the Conference

Background

Asia is the world's largest and most populous continent with a population of about 4.5 billion people as of 05 Jul 2020. Together with Africa's 1.3 billion people, both continents altogether are hosting about 74% of the world population. Coupled with a high growth rate, it is imperative that both Asia and Africa establishes an international research organisation that specifically focus on the well-being of the Asian / African communities.

Hence, the establishment of ABRA (Association of Behavioural Researchers on Asians), officially formalised on 20th October 2014, represented by seven member countries – Egypt, Iran, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Taiwan and Turkey. ABRA was renamed the Association of Behavioural Researchers on Asians/Africans/Arabians on 26 Jun 2020, with the inclusion of three new member countries – Morocco, Nigeria and Saudi Arabia. AMER (ABRAMalaysia) with its headquarters in Shah Alam, Malaysia is the permanent secretariat for ABRAworldwide.

To mark the establishment of ABRAworldwide, the maiden international conference AQoL2014 (ABRA International Conference on Quality of Life) was held in Istanbul, Turkey, from 26-28 December 2014. The 1st ABRAworldwide Board Meeting was also held in conjunction with the conference. To enhance the QoL conferences further, the AQoL to be held in non-ASEAN countries (except Malaysia) shall be the sister conference to the more established annual AicQoL (AMER International Conference on Quality of Life), held in the ASEAN countries. Both back-to-back AQoL conferences form the ASLI (Annual Serial Landmark International Conferences on QoL).

Sadly, ABRA was deregistered in Mar 2023, due to the inability to conduct proper AGMs from 2015-2019. It should be noted during that period, online meetings were not yet popular. Attending the AGM physically was beyond the means of the members due to the lack of travelling fund.

Commencing 2023, the AQoL will be renamed as "Asia-Pacific International Conference on Quality of Life". The anchor theme of the conference being "Quality of Life in the Built & Natural Environment".

The conference focuses on QoL issues affecting the Asian/African/Arabian communities in both their countries and nons. Issues affecting other communities are also most welcomed.

Paper presenters are allowed to either present F2F or virtually. However, only those who present F2F shall be in the running for the Best Paper awards, amounting to more than cash MYR 10,500.00 with the grand prize of cash MYR 3,000.00 for THE Best Paper.

The e-IPH, UK published both the Abstract Book (eISBN 978-1-913576-14-1), and the Proceeding in the E-BPJ (Environment-Behaviour Proceedings Journal), eISSN 2398-4287, 9(28) Jun 2024, issue. Currently, the E-BPJ is indexed in Clavirate Analytics Web of Science (WoS) and ScienceOpen. Extended versions of the selected papers shall be published as freely accessible articles, online, in our other international journals –ajE-Bs or jABs, @ no publication charges.

Continuing with our Game Changer 2021 initiative, #GC2021 – only internationally-authored* (for Malaysians) papers shall be considered for publications in the Proceedings (E-BPJ), and in our other international journals.

(* At least one of the authors must be from abroad; Failing which, a 100% additional surcharge of the published Registration Fees shall apply. Those from abroad must not be Malaysians, nor non-Malaysians studying/working in Malaysia. The co-author from abroad must also not co-authored in another paper. Failing which all the papers they co-authored will be disqualified in the running for the Best Paper awards).

Conference Policy

- 1) **All instructions** for submissions should be strictly followed.
- 2) **Authors names** together with the sequencing are not allowed to be changed (strictly). Authors names as per the Abstract approved should also be used for the Full Paper. Numbers of authors exceeding the max 4 shall be surcharged RM300. For 6-8 numbers of authors shall be surcharged an additional RM800.
- 3) **All communications** shall be transmitted to the 1st Author only (strictly), the email as per submitted in the Abstract. Please cite your Abstract No. for all communications.
- 4) **Submission deadlines** as per the conference Timeline is strictly adhered.
- 5) **All payments** received are non-refundable (including cancellation of participation, abstracts / papers rejected, or non-submission of amended full paper within the deadlines). **Registration Fees** shall be based on the status of the 1st Author, no matter whoever shall be presenting.
- 6) **Attendance** is NOT compulsory for your Oral Presentation. The papers shall still be considered for publication in the final Proceeding (E-BPJ). However, non-Oral Presentation and non-payment for Publication Fees to be submitted together with the Conference Registration Fees shall disqualify the papers from being considered for the Best Paper Awards.
- 7) **Oral Presenters** attending must register during the stipulated time as per the Programme (*Latecomers shall be considered as not presenting @ not attending*). Oral Presenters should have submitted their power point presentation at least 1 week before the conference, so that the presentation schedule can be finalised by then.
- 8) **Breakout Schedules** shall be released during the Conf Registration. As Oral Presenters are expected to attend the whole session, any special request for rescheduling of their oral presentation does not arise.
- 9) **Full Papers** accepted for the conference is not a guarantee that it would be published in the final Proceeding. It is compulsory to submit both the non-refundable Conference Registration Fees and Publication Fees, together with the Full Paper submission. Failing which, the Full Paper shall not be reviewed, nor published even in the draft Proceeding.
- 10) **Publication** of the Conference Proceeding shall be based on the amended full papers only, as recommended by the International Scientific Committee (ISC). The draft Proceeding published in the conference web during the conference is solely meant as a reference for participants during the conference.
- 11) **Conference Packs and Certificates** shall only be provided to participants who attend the conference physically. The Conference Packs must be collected on conference eve. The Certificate must be collected during the certificate presentation ceremony / Dinner. No special request will be entertained.
- 12) **Conference e-Certificates** for virtual participants shall be emailed to participants attending. Only one certificate per person shall be issued, that is Presenter, Co-Author or Participant.
- 13) **Visa** application for face-to-face conferences is the sole responsibility of the participant. Please apply **Tourist Visa** (Not visa for attending the conference) on your own. The Organiser will not issue any Letter of Support for Visa Application, and should not be held responsible if you could not obtain your visa in time for the conference.

14) Administrative Fees RM200 surcharged for any inconvenience to Conf Sec.

15) Publication matters for papers rejected, a Note of Appeal must be sent immediately to the Editor-in-Chief via admin@e-iph.co.uk and c.c. to the Conf Sec.

16. All submissions (Abstracts and Full Papers) cannot be withdrawn/cancelled.

Best Paper Awards Policy

To encourage more quality papers to be submitted, several Best Paper awards with up for grabs an overall total of more than Cash (RM10,500.00) + Free Registration Fees for future conferences.

1) The ranking for the Best Paper Awards shall be based only on the papers: -

- (a) Orally presented (F2F) at the conference.
- (b) Published in the E-BPJ, whereby the Publication Fees is required to be submitted together with the compulsory Conference Registration Fees during the full paper submission process.
- (c) With a score above 70%.
- (d) With international co-author (for Malaysians) not co-authoring more than 1 paper. (All other papers co-authored by the same International co-author will be disqualified)

2) Award winners (not representative) must be present during the Best Paper Award Announcement Ceremony. Failing which, they shall be disqualified.

3) The Best Paper Awards Certificates and the Cash prizes shall be provided within 1 week after the ceremony.
