### Foreword

This 13th Asia-Pacific International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies, AicE-Bs2025, being held at the University of Westminster, London, UK from 29-31 Aug 2025 is organised by AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers), in collaboration with the College of Built Environment, Universiti Teknologi MARA, Malaysia and Design, Creative and Digital Industries, University of Westminster, London, UK. It marked AMER's 50th international conference to be organised, and fully managed by AMER's subsidiary, emAs (AMER Event Management & Services) under emAs emAs Resources

The Game Changer 2021 (#GC2021) initiated in early 2021 whereby it is compulsory for contributions from Malaysia to include international co-authors, is to increase our publications to be contributed by multi-national authors. We believe that initiative would tremendously increases the chances for our publications to be indexed by more reputable indexing bodies, such as Scopus. As such, commencing 2021 only multi-national authored contributions from Malaysia shall be accepted for publications.

AicE-Bs2025 managed to attract an overall total of 48 numbers of approved abstracts, of which authors from 16 countries contributed. Majority of the abstracts were in collaboration with Malaysian authors. The most were together with Indonesia (18 numbers / 38%); followed by China (12); United Kingdom (3); Morocco, Nigeria, and Saudi Arabia (2 each); Canada, France, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, New Zealand, Thailand, United States of America, and Uzbekistan (1 each)

The approved 48 abstracts were finally transformed into 43 approved full papers, a return of 90%. The papers approved were simply grouped generally under 19 sub-categories, although quite a number could have been easily placed under more than one category. The top four categories in order of popularity involved the Educational / Learning Environment (ELE) with 8 papers, Health / Healing Environment (HE) with 6 papers, Commercial / Retail / Services Environment (CRSE) with 5 papers, and Communication / Social Mesia environment (CSME) with 4 papers.

Thanks again for your continuous support and contributions as always, and hope for an enlightening conference!

## **Background**

The M1iCES (Malaysia's 1st International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies) officially soft-launched by Malaysian Director General, Womens Development Department, Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development during 1nCEBS (14-15 November 2009) had been renamed the ASIA Pacific International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies (AicE-Bs). AicE-Bs conference themes address Environment-Behaviour issues affecting the Asia/Pacific region. In particular, on issues affecting the Asian communities living in both Asian and non-Asian countries. Issues affecting non-Asian communities are also most welcome.

Prior to 2014, AicE-Bs were organised annually by cE-Bs, Centre for Environment-Behaviour Studies, Universiti Teknologi MARA, Malaysia in collaboration with ABRA (Association of Behavioural Researchers on Asians.Africans/Arabians), AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers) and non-ASEAN ajE-Bs / jABs Editorial Board member's establishment (as the National Conference now renamed Asian Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies – AcE-Bs shall be held in Asian members' countries). Post 2014, all AicE-Bs conferences shall be organised in non-Asian countries, except Malaysia. It shall be fully managed by emAs (AMER Event Management Services), under emAs emAs Resources.

## **Conference Policy**

- 1) All instructions for submissions should be strictly followed.
- 2) Authors names together with the sequencing are not allowed to be changed (strictly). Authors names as per the Abstract approved should also be used for the Full Paper. Numbers of authors exceeding the max 4 shall be surcharged RM400. For 6-8 numbers of authors shall be surcharged an additional RM800.
- 3) All communications shall be transmitted to the 1st Author only (strictly), the email as per submitted in the Abstract. Please cite your Abstract No. for all communications.
- 4) Submission deadlines as per the conference Timeline is strictly adhered.
- 5)All payments received are non-refundable (including cancellation of participation, abstracts / papers rejected, or non-submission of amended full paper within the deadlines).
- 6) Conference Registration Form must be filled by the 1st Author.
- 7) Registration Fee & Publication Fee will be based on the status of the 1st Author, no matter whoever shall be presenting.
- 8) Attendance is NOT compulsory for your Oral Presentation. The papers shall still be considered for publication in the final Proceeding (E-BPJ). However, non-Oral Presentation and non-payment for Publication Fees to be submitted together with the Conference Registration Fees shall disqualify the papers from being considered for the Best Paper Awards.
- 9) Oral Presenters attending must register during the stipulated time as per the Programme (Latecomers shall be considered as not presenting @ not attending). Oral Presenters should have submitted their power point presentation at least 1 week before the conference, so that the presentation schedule can be finalised by then.
- **10) Breakout Schedules** shall be released during the Conf Registration. As Oral Presenters are expected to attend the whole session, any special request for rescheduling of their oral presentation does not arise.
- 11) Full Papers accepted for the conference is not a guarantee that it would be published in the final Proceeding. It is compulsory to submit both the non-refundable Conference Registration Fees and Publication Fees, together with the Full Paper submission. Failing which, the Full Paper shall not be reviewed, nor published even in the draft Proceeding.
- **12) Publication** of the Conference Proceeding shall be based on the amended full papers only, as recommended by the International Scientific Committee (ISC). The draft Proceeding published in the conference web during the conference is solely meant as a reference for participants during the conference.
- 13) Conference Packs and Certificates shall only be provided to participants who attend the conference physically. The Certificate must be collected during the certificate presentation ceremony / Dinner. No special request will be entertained.
- **14) Conference e-Certificates** for virtual participants shall be emailed to participants attending. Only one certificate per person shall be issued, that is Presenter, Co-Author or Participant.

- **15) Visa** application for face-to-face conferences is the sole responsibility of the participant. Please apply **Tourist Visa** (Not visa for attending the conference) on your own. The Organiser will not issue any Letter of Support for Visa Application, and should not be held responsible if you could not obtain your visa in time for the conference.
- 16) Administrative Fees RM200 surcharged for any inconvenience to Conf Sec.
- 17) Publication matters for papers rejected, a Note of Appeal must be sent immediately to the Editor-in-Chief via admin@e-iph.co.uk and c.c. to the Conf Sec.
- **16. All submissions** (Abstracts and Full Papers) cannot be withdrawn/cancelled.

## **Best Paper Awards Policy**

To encourage more quality papers to be submitted, several Best Paper awards with up for grabs an overall total of more than Cash (RM10,500.00) + Free Registration Fees for future conferences.

- 1) The ranking for the Best Paper Awards shall be based only on the papers: -
- (a) Orally presented (F2F) at the conference.
- (b) Published in the E-BPJ, whereby the Publication Fees is required to be submitted together with the compulsory Conference Registration Fees during the full paper submission process.
- (c) Wth a score above 70%.
- (d) With international co-author (for Malaysians) not co-authoring more than 1 paper. (All other papers co-authored by the same International co-author will be disqualified)

All our journals published by the e-IPH, UK with the ISSN obtained from the British Library, UK are international multidisciplinary Open Access Journals which adhere to the BOAI definition of open access:that users have the right to 'read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles'. The journals published double-blind peer-reviewed, original research articles relating issues affecting the Asian communities living in both the Asian and non- Asian countries, worldwide. Successful articles published had attained an equivalent minimum score of 90% for the English Language and Similarity Index (Plagiarism) of not more than 15%, based on Grammarl
