Foreword

This 14th Asia-Pacific International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies, AicE-Bs2026, being held at the Kyungdong University Global (KDU Global), Sokcho, South Korea, from 04-06 Jun 2026, which is fully managed by AMER's subsidiary, emAs (AMER Event Management & Services) under emAs emAs Resources, marks AMER's 54th international conference to be organised,

The Game Changer 2021 (#GC2021), initiated in early 2021, which requires that contributions from Malaysia include international co-authors aimed to increase the number of publications contributed by multinational authors. We believe that the initiative would significantly increase the likelihood that our publications will be indexed by more reputable indexing bodies, such as Scopus. As such, commencing in 2021, only multinational-authored contributions from Malaysia will be accepted for publication.

As anticipated, the new Clarivate Analytics ruling for publications commencing Jan 2026, which would not be automatically WoS-indexed as in previous years, has significantly reduced the number of participants. Nevertheless, AicE-Bs2026Sokcho, still managed to attract a total of 44 approved abstracts, with authors from 17 countries. The majority of the abstracts were in collaboration with Malaysian authors (26 numbers). International contributions were obtained from South Korea (18), Indonesia (9), China (6), Morocco and Uzbekistan (2 each), and one each from Brunei, Canada, France, India, Japan, New Zealand, Pakistan, Philippines, Thailand, Türkiye and United Kingdom.

The approved abstracts were grouped into 16 subcategories, although many could have been easily placed under more than one category. The top four categories, in order of popularity, were Artificial Intelligence Environment (22.2%), Tourism / Hospitality Environment (13.3%), Health / Healing Environment (11.1%), Sustainable Environment and Technology-related Environment (8.9% each).

The approved abstracts were finally transformed into 38 approved full papers, a return of 84.0%. The papers approved were simply grouped generally under 14 sub-categories, although quite a number could have been easily placed under more than one category.

The top four categories, in order of popularity, were Artificial Intelligence Environment with 9 papers, Health / Healing Environment (5), Tourism / Hospitality Environment (4), and Educational / Learning Environment (3).

Thanks again for your continuous support and contributions as always, and hope for an enlightening conference!

Background

The M1ICES (Malaysia's 1st International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies) officially soft-launched by Malaysian Director General, Womens Development Department, Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development during 1nCEBS (14-15 November 2009) had been renamed the ASIA Pacific International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies (AicE-Bs). AicE-Bs conference themes address Environment-Behaviour issues affecting the Asia/Pacific region. In particular, on issues affecting the Asian communities living in both Asian and non-Asian countries. Issues affecting non-Asian communities are also most welcome.

Prior to 2014, AicE-Bs were organised annually by cE-Bs in collaboration with ABRA (Association of Behavioural Researchers on Asians.Africans/Arabians) / AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers) and non-ASEAN ajE-Bs / jABs Editorial Board member's establishment (as the National Conference now renamed Asian Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies – AcE-Bs shall be held in Asian members' countries), Post 2014, all AicE-Bs conferences shall be organised in non-Asian countries, except Malaysia. It shall be fully managed by emAs (AMER Event Management Services), under emAs emAs Resources.

- 1) **All instructions** for submissions should be strictly followed.
- 2) **Authors names** together with the sequencing are not allowed to be changed (strictly). Authors names as per the Abstract approved should also be used for the Full Paper. Numbers of authors exceeding the max 4 shall be surcharged RM400. For 6-8 numbers of authors shall be surcharged an additional RM800.
- 3) **All communications** shall be transmitted to the 1st Author only (strictly), the email as per submitted in the Abstract. Please cite your Abstract No. for all communications.
- 4) **Submission deadlines** as per the conference Timeline is strictly adhered.
- 5) **All payments** received are non-refundable (including cancellation of participation, abstracts / papers rejected, or non-submission of amended full paper within the deadlines). **Registration Fees** shall be based on the status of the 1st Author, no matter whoever shall be presenting.
